

Safety on the Road: On road trips, make sure baby is buckled into her infant car seat. 85% of car seats are not installed correctly. Visit www.safekids.org to learn how to properly install your car seat. If you are expecting, consider choosing from the Chicco KeyFit Infant Car Seat family, which is home to the #1 rated car seat in America for ease of installation.





When flying, consider purchasing an extra ticket for your infant and installing your infant car seat. Chicco's KeyFit Infant Car Seats are FAA certified.

Safe Kids USA's position regarding air travel is that "infants and toddlers on airplanes are safest in an approved car seat with a harness, in case of turbulence. "A child who rides in a car seat on the ground should ride in that car seat on a plane," said Chrissy Cianflone, Director of Program Operations for Safe Kids USA. "Air turbulence can be dangerous and can appear suddenly without warning."

Be Sun Safe: Babies younger than 6 months shouldn't wear sunscreen, so be sure that baby is under wraps when outside. A sun hat and lightweight long sleeves and pants keep baby protected without much fuss. When out strolling, be sure to open stroller sun shades all the way. The Chicco Cortina Travel System offers full sun protection for your newborn.

One tip for **Cortina** users: When your stroller is folded, unlock rear wheels and move the handle to its highest position to roll the stroller behind you. This is especially useful when traveling with kids and bags.





Keep Playtime Cool: Take time to play in the shade and during the heat of the day, consider bringing the fun inside. Bring one or two multi-function inside toys on vacation to keep kids entertained without having to bring the entire toy chest.
