Setup

Charging the battery

Connect the charging cable to the keyboard and a USB port. The red charging indicator will shine during charging and turn green when the battery is fully charged. Charge the battery again when you see the power indicator flash red.

Power on/off

The keyboard turns on and off through contact with the magnetic strips. Open the case and position the holder against one of the two magnetic strips. The power indicators will light up.

The keyboard will enter sleep mode if it's turned on and not used for 15 minutes. Press any key to wake it up again.

Pairing with your device

- 1. Activate Bluetooth on your device.
- Turn on the keyboard. Press the Fn and Bluetooth keys simultaneously. The left power indicator will flash blue.
- 3. Search for nearby Bluetooth devices. Select the keyboard from the list.
- 4. Enter the numeric code on the keyboard when asked. Your keyboard is ready for use when the left power indicator turns off.

Indicator lights

Left:

- Green light: CapsLock on
- Flashing blue light: Bluetooth pairing mode
- Flashing red light: Low battery

Right:

- Green light: Power on
- Red light: Charging battery
