

Basic Operation

1. Charge the battery

Note: Charge the device before using it the first time

- a) Connect the Micro USB cable to the device.
- b) Connect the other end of the Micro USB cable to the USB power adapter (wall charger), then plug the adapter into a power outlet. It takes about 5 hours to fully charge the device.

2. Start the device
