Gentlemen:

Enclosed, please find Philips Electronics Industries (Taiwan) Ltd.'s application for equipment authorization dated March 30, 2000. The subject device was originally granted on October 13, 1999 in compliance with Part 15, Subpart B of the FCC Rules.


This device was previously reported as a 15" LCD Monitor that supports 30-61 kHz horizontal and 56-75 Hz vertical sync frequencies with maximum resolution up to 1024x768, Non-Interlaced. Also, this monitor was reported as provided with such features as: (1) 15" TFT Color Flat LCD Panel types LQ150X1DG12, LM151X2, (2) base stand with detachable shielded 15-Pin D-Sub connector signal cable with two bonded ferrite cores and 24-Pin D-Sub connector for digital input; (3) detachable non-shielded power supply cord; and (4) base unit may be provided with optional USB ports (one-upstream and four-downstream) and audio functions with audio interface cable with one bonded ferrite core.

This Class II Change is to report: (1) new cabinet style for Philips Model 150B1; (2) alternate LCD Panel; (3) re-layout of main chassis board; (4) deleted USB ports and audio functions; (5) deleted digital input connector; and (6) added Philips AC Adaptor model UP06031180A with DC cable with one ferrite core to replace built-in power supply. Refer to attached photographs for details.

This modified monitor was system tested in accordance with C63.4-1992 to show compliance to FCC Part 15 Class B limits. Compliance tests were performed in representative worst-case video modes 1024x768 @ 48.3 kHz and 60 kHz with 15-Pin D-Sub connector and AC Adaptor.
