This device was originally reported as 17" Digital Autoscan Color Monitor provided with such features as: (1) 30-86 kHz horizontal, 50-160 Hz vertical sync frequencies and maximum resolution up to 1280x1024, Non-Interlaced; (2) 1.8m detachable non-shielded power supply cord; (3) 1.8m permanently attached shielded D-Sub connector signal cable with two external bonded ferrite cores; (4) audio power amplifier with built-in speaker and (5) microphone and headphone jacks for multimedia applications.

This Class II Change is to report: (1) decrease horizontal sync frequency to 30-70 kHz with same maximum resolution up to 1280x1024, Non-Interlaced; (2) delete audio power amplifier with built-in speaker (3) delete microphone and headphone jacks; (4) new front and back cabinet; (5) change signal output interface cable to two internal ferrite cores on inside the enclosure and one external ferrite core on the outside enclosure near the 15-Pin D-Sub connector; and (6) new CRT with and improved video printed circuit board.

This EUT was system tested in accordance with C63.4-1992 to show compliance to FCC Part 15 Class B limits. Compliance tests were performed in two representative worst-case video modes 1024x768 @ 68.7 kHz and 1280x1024 @ 60 kHz.
