## Enhancements

- GUI improvements.
- Support SNMP access from WAN side.
- Support certificates for IPSec VPN IKE authentication.
- Support DDNS update periodically.

## Issues Resolved

- After rebooting or upgrading the device, schedule-based firewall access rules do not work. (CSCuo66872)

## Release Notes

---

- If users enable QoS, configure the Ethernet upstream and downstream rate limit, and then create or delete a new VLAN, the downstream rate limit does not work. (CSCuo94504)
- Sometimes, after Ethernet WAN, or 3G interface failover, LAN hosts are unable to access the Internet. (CSCuo64951)
- Wireless clients may not be able to access the Internet when roaming between the device and another access point on the LAN side. (CSCum42666)
- OpenSSL upgrade. (CSCuo18651)
- Changing default LAN IP should be optional when VPN server is enabled. (CSCul19364)
- DNS proxy doesn't always work. (CSCuo97062)
- DNS configuration was lost when configuring WAN in setup wizard. (CSCuo85131)
- Static DHP will only recognize ~44 entires. (CSCus89995)
- Changing default in LAN IP should be optional when VPN server is enabled. (CSCul19364)

## Known Issues

### Caveats Acknowledged in Firmware Version 1.0.2.7

**Problem:** Backup configuration file fails to restore to device. (CSCuv07239)

**Solution:** Delete some URL entries in the Internet Access Policy rules then backup the configuration.

**Problem:** If Dead Peer Detection is enabled, the IPsec VPN tunnel may reconnect in case of heavy traffic. (CSCum72973)

**Solution:** Limit heavy traffic over the VPN tunnel.
