

Listening to Music Wirelessly

Please ensure that your device (iPhone, Tablet or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

Function	Operation	Button
Increase Volume	Playing music	Press and hold the + button to increase the volume.
Decrease Volume	Playing music	Press and hold the - button to decrease the volume.
Pause	Playing music	Short press the Play/Pause button will pause the music.
Play	Pausing	Short press the Play/Pause button will resume the music
Previous track	Playing music	Short press the – button, it will go to previous track.
Next track	Playing music	Short press the + button, it will go to the next track.

(Note: The above functions only can be used in Bluetooth mode only. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level. In Aux mode, besides the volume increase decrease, you will need to control through your source device.)

Stream music from Micro SD (TF) Card or USB Flash Drive -

- Insert the Micro SD (TF) Card or USB Flash Drive preloaded with songs, insert the Micro SD (TF) Card Slot or USB Slot of the speaker respectively. Speaker would automatically start playing songs from the Micro SD (TF) Card or USB Drive
- Note: Micro SD Card & USB Flash Drive not included.
- To Skip Track Forward Short press the +button to Skip Forward button
- To Skip Track Backwards Short press the –button to Skip Backward button
- To Pause the Track Short press the Play/Pause button.
 To Play the Track Short press the Play/Pause button.
- · Long press + to increase the volume or to decrease the volume

Play music through "Auxiliary" mode

- Insert one end of the Auxiliary cable into the Auxiliary port, and the other end to the audio device (such as phone / MP3 Player / computer / tablet /etc.).
- Select your favourite song at the source device to play.
- Long press + to increase the volume or to decrease the volume.
- Note: Media can be controlled only through the source devices, while playing music in Auxiliary mode

- 1. Press the "Mode button" to switch different functions of the speaker between Bluetooth / AUX-In / Micro SD (TF)-USB
- 2. When the speaker is not in use, turn it OFF in order to save the battery power.

FM MODE

- 1 Turn ON the speaker
- 2. Press the "Mode button" to switch FM mode, when switch to FM mode, there will have a tone coming up "FM MODE", then press the play/pause button, it will go to auto search mode and auto store stations. After searching all FM stations, that will stop and playing the 1st station.





Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low sound level	Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop, etc.) volume too low. Battery dead	Adjust source volume. Charge Battery.
Sound distorted	Battery nearly dead	Charge Battery.
Source (Tablet, Mobile Phone, Laptop.) turned off. Speaker turned off. Volume turned down source. Media paused on source.		Turn the source on. Turn the speaker on. Adjust volume source. Plav media from source.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

The speaker has built-in rechargeable battery. When the battery is drained out, speaker would turn OFF automatically. Please recharge the battery every time it drains out

Plug the Micro USB end of the included USB rechargeable cable into the charging port. Plug the other end into a USB port on your computer or other devices made for USB charging. Red LED Light illuminates indicating that the device is being charged.

It takes approximately 2 hours to fully charge the speaker. Once the speaker is fully charged, LED Light would turn OFF.

It is recommended to fully charge the speaker before its first use.

Turning ON/OFF the Speaker -

Before Turning ON the speaker, please ensure that it is fully charged. Slide the ON/OFF switch to ON/OFF position to turn on/off the unit

Connect using Bluetooth Technology

- Slide the ON/OFF switch to ON position to turn on. You would hear an indication tone and Blue LED would flash rapidly, indicating that you are now in Bluetooth Pairing Mode.
- Activate the Bluetooth function on your source device (Mobile Phone or Tablet). Please refer to
- manufacturer's instructions for instructions on enabling Bluetooth on your device.

 Search for available Bluetooth devices and you would find "Sylvania SP434" Pair it with this device.
- If required, enter the password "0000" to pair with the device.
 Once paired successfully, you will hear another indication tone, and Blue LED stays on.
- · You can now stream wireless music on your speaker through your source device

Talking using the Bluetooth Speaker

Please ensure that you are paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to use the below functions.

Function	Operation	Button
Tulicuon	Operation	Button
Answer Incoming Call	Incoming Call	Press the Phone once to answer an incoming call.
Reject incoming call	Incoming Call	Press and hold the Phone button for 2 seconds.
End Call	Incoming Call	After your phone conversation, short press the Phone button.
Increase Volume	During a call	Press and hold the + button to increase the volume.
Decrease Volume	During a call	Press and hold the - button to decrease the volume.
Redial last number	Connected to a device	Short press the Phone button twice.
