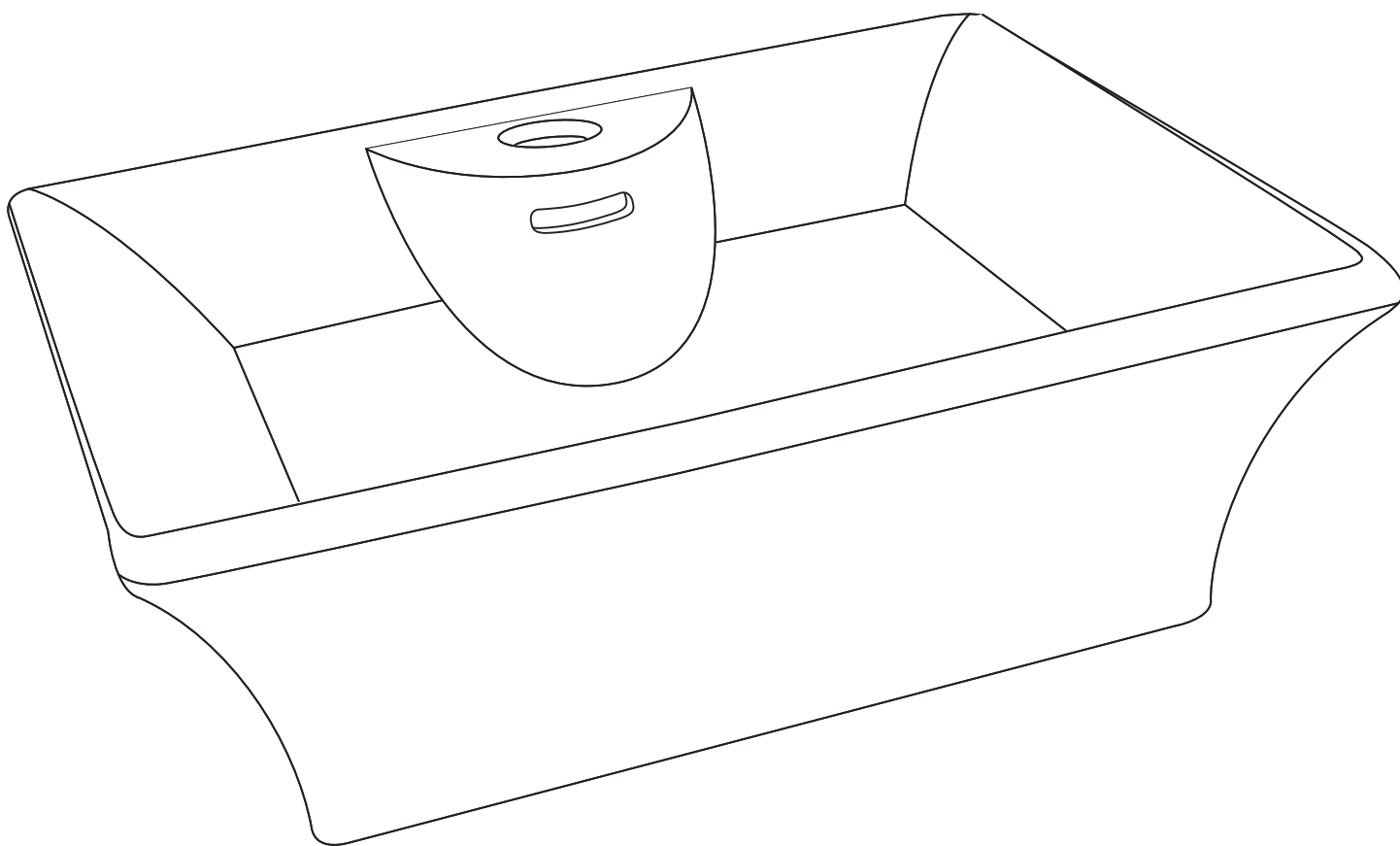

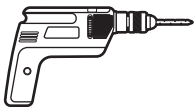
PLANNING INSTALLATION

Before beginning installation of this product, remove your new vessel sink from the package and carefully inspect it for damage. Return the vessel sink to its packaging until you are ready to install it.

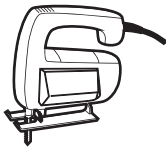

Installation

1 Cutting the counter top

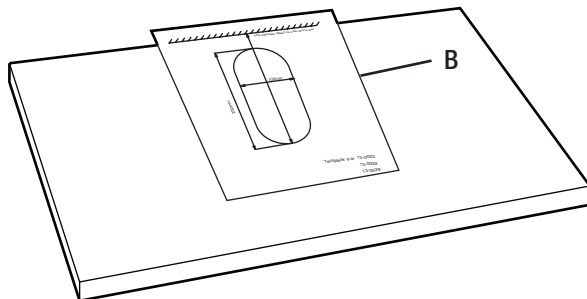


NOTE: To avoid possible damage to the cabinet, cut the counter top before installing the counter top to the cabinet.

- Affix the template (B) provided to the counter top at the desired location with cellophane tape.
- Using a pencil, mark guidelines on the counter top following the template (B).
- Drill a clearance hole approximately 1/4 in. to 1/2 in. inside the perimeter line of template (B).
- Cut an opening following the perimeter line of template (B).



NOTE: For harder surfaces, have the counter top professionally cut following the template provided.

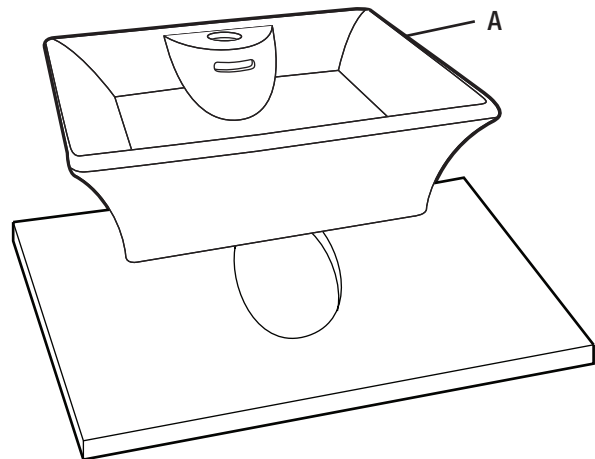


2 Positioning the sink

- Center the sink (A) and line up the drain over the cutout to ensure the sink (A) fits easily into the opening.



NOTE: It is recommended to practice the proper insertion two or three times before applying sealant.



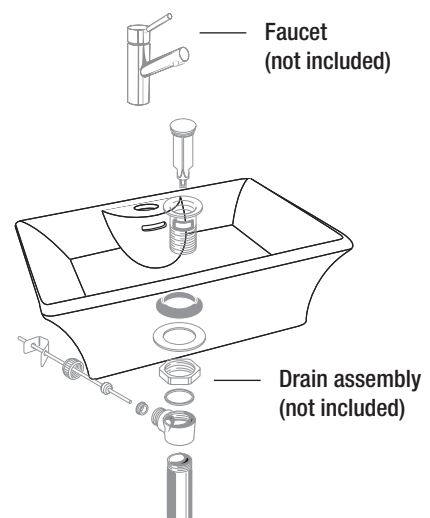
3 Installing a drain and plumbing fittings

- Install a drain (not provided) according to manufacturer's installation instructions.



CAUTION: Do not overtighten the drain assembly as this could break the porcelain.

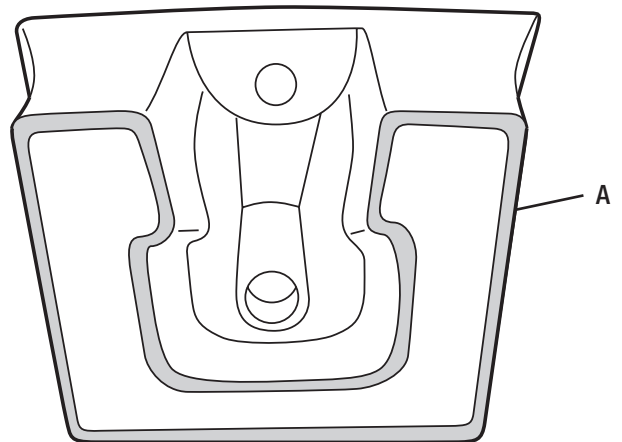
- Install the plumbing fittings (not provided) according to the manufacturer's instructions.



Installation (Continued)

4 Installing the sink

- Apply plumber's putty or caulking around the underside rim of the sink (A) near the edge, as shown.
- Carefully lower the sink (A) in place, align it, and press down firmly to adhere the sink (A) to the counter top.
- Wipe off excess sealant.
- Connect the water supply and P-Trap (not provided) as required.
- Check for leaks.



Care and Cleaning

- Clean the outside surface with mild soap, warm water and a soft cloth.
- On stubborn stains use a powdered detergent and damp sponge or nylon scouring pad.
- Never use abrasive scouring powders, cleansers, or pads because they will scratch, damage, and dull the surface.
