Breville recommends safety first

We at Breville are very safety conscious. We design and manufacture consumer products with the safety of you, our valued customer, foremost in mind. In addition, we ask that you exercise a degree of care when using any electrical appliance and adhere to the following instructions.

Important safeguards for your Breville ikon™ Quiet Boil Kettle

- Carefully read all instructions before operation and save for future reference.
- Remove any packaging material and promotional labels before using the kettle for the first time.
- This appliance has been designed specifically for the purpose of boiling drinking quality water only. Under no circumstances should this product be used to boil any other liquids or foodstuffs.
- Do not place the kettle near the edge of a bench or table during operation. Ensure that the surface is level, clean and free of water.
- Do not let the power cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, touch hot surfaces or become knotted. Fully unwind power cord before use.
- Keep the kettle clear of walls, curtains and other heat or steam sensitive materials.
 Minimum 200mm distance.
- Do not place on or near a gas burner, electric element or in or near a heated oven.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse the kettle base, switch area, power base, power supply, power cord or power plug in water or allow moisture to come in contact with these parts.
- Always ensure the kettle switch is in the 'OFF' position, then turn the power off at the power outlet and remove the power plug from the power outlet before attempting to move the appliance, when the appliance is not in use and before cleaning and storing.
- Do not remove the kettle from the power base during operation. Ensure the kettle has switched to 'OFF' position, after water has boiled, before removing the kettle from the power base.

- Do not move the kettle while it is switched on.
- Do not open the lid during operation.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use the handle for lifting and carrying the kettle.
- Keep the appliance clean. Refer to care and cleaning (page 8)
- This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons unless they have been adequately supervised by a responsible person to ensure they can use the appliance safely.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance.
- It is recommended to regularly inspect the appliance. Do not use the appliance if power supply, power cord, power plug or appliance becomes damaged in any way. Return the entire appliance to the nearest authorised Breville centre for examination and/or repair.
- Any maintenance other than cleaning should be performed at an authorised Breville Service Centre.
- This appliance is recommended for household use only. Do not use this appliance for other than its intended use. Do not use in moving vehicles or boats. Do not use outdoors.
- The installation of a residual current device (safety switch) is recommended to provide additional safety protection when using electrical appliances. It is advisable that a safety switch with a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA be installed in the electrical circuit supplying the appliance. See your electrician for professional advice.

Breville Quiet Boil Technology

Your Breville ikon™ Quiet Boil Kettle includes Quiet Boil Technology, a new development that will make boiling water in the kettle a quieter experience.

please carefully read the following instructions

how it works

The innovative Quiet Boil Technology reduces the size of the water bubbles, minimising the noise level during heating. It is only at boiling point that a light bubbling noise can be heard which will indicate that the water has boiled.

maintaining the Quiet Boil Technology

Through regular use over time, scale can build up in the kettle that can affect the performance of the Quiet Boil Technology as well as the life of the kettle. Lime and Phosphate are common forms of scale that can damage your kettle.

Lime scale, a harmless mineral, comes in the appearance of white, coloured or rusty-looking build up on the inner walls of the kettle. Phosphate scale can't be seen, however, it can cause the water to appear cloudy when heated.

To prevent scale from damaging your kettle, ensure that the kettle is de-scaled regularly. This is done by emptying the kettle after use and not allowing water to stand in the kettle overnight.

We recommend the use of a proprietary de-scaler such as the Breville Kettle Cleaner to remove scale build up and stains.

do not use vinegar to clean the inside of the kettle as it may affect the performance of the Quiet Boil technology.

operating your Breville ikon™ Quiet Boil Kettle

Before first use

Remove any promotional material attached to your kettle. It is recommended that before first use the kettle is filled to the maximum level, boiled and water discarded. Your kettle will only operate when positioned on the power base with the On/Off switch in the 'On' position. The kettle will automatically switch off once the water has boiled.

operation of your kettle

- To fill the kettle, remove it from the power base and open the lid by pressing the lid release button. Fill with the desired amount of water. Always fill the kettle between the minimum and maximum marks on the water window. Too little water will result in the kettle switching off before the water has boiled.
- Ensure that the lid is locked firmly into place. Place the kettle firmly onto the power base. Power plug the power cord into 230/240V power point and switch 'On'.
- 3. Press the On/Off switch to the 'On' position. The power 'On' light and the water gauge will illuminate.

always fill the kettle between the minimum (min) and the maximum (max) marks on the exterior of the kettle. Too little water will result in the kettle switching "off" before the water has boiled. filling above the maximum mark on the exterior of the kettle may result in boiling water splashing from the kettle.

Note

This kettle must only be used with the power base supplied. use caution when pouring water from your kettle, as boiling water will scald. do not pour the water too quickly.

Note

The kettle will automatically switch 'Off' once the water has boiled. Lift the kettle from the power base and pour the water. Take care to hold the kettle level, especially when filled to the maximum level. To re-boil it may be necessary to wait for a few seconds to allow the control to reset.

The kettle may be stored on its power base when not in use. The power point should be switched off and the appliance power plug unpower plugged from the power when not in use.

safety boil dry protection

The kettle is fitted with a safety device, which protects against overheating should the appliance be operated with insufficient water. If this occurs the kettle will stop heating. Switch 'Off' at the power point and allow kettle to cool before refilling. The safety device will automatically reset when the kettle has cooled down.

For additional safety your kettle is fitted with an additional thermal cut out. In the event of overheating, the kettle will automatically shut down to prevent further damage. Should this occur, take your kettle to an authorised Breville Service Centre.

Care and cleaning

Always switch off at the power outlet, and then unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.

r emovable filter

The ikon[™] Quiet Boil Kettle features a removable mesh filter to filter out scale deposits for cleaner water. To remove the scale deposits remove the filter by opening the lid and lifting up and out of the kettle.

The filter can be cleaned by running under hot water and rubbing with a cleaning cloth or brush.

To replace filter, simply slide the filter down into the slot behind the spout of the kettle.

r emoval of mineral deposits

Mineral deposits in tap water may cause the kettle interior and water gauge to discolour over time.

We recommend the use of a proprietary de-scaler such as the Breville Kettle Cleaner to remove scale build up and stains. do not use vinegar to clean the inside of the kettle as it may affect the performance of the Quiet Boil technology.

Note

To clean the exterior

The outside of the kettle may be wiped over with a damp cloth and polished with a soft dry cloth.

do not use chemical, steel wool, or abrasive cleaners to clean the outside of the kettle.
