

- Once connected you will hear a voice prompt "The device is connected successfully".
- To shut down the Bluetooth function on the current connected device, the headphone will go to pairing mode again with red and blue light flashing and is available to be connected with a different device.

Phone calls

- Press power button to pick up /hang up phone calls.
- Press and hold power button for 2 seconds to reject calls.
- Press power button twice to call the previous number called.

Voice Activating

Press the power button 3 times to activate your phone assistant to play music, make phone calls or respond to message, etc.

When the headphone connects with the electronic device via Bluetooth you can enjoy music through the headphone wirelessly.

Battery Charging
