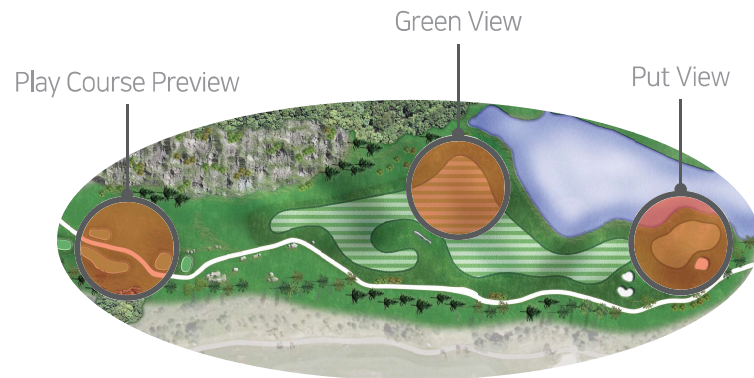


## V.AI™?

## Time/Date Settings

### Automatic Setting (Outdoor Only)

## Time Settings

### Manual Setting (Indoor/Outdoor)

### Watch Face Settings

## Course View, Green View, Put View, Yardage View Screen

slide to left (←) to enter 'Green View'  
slide to right (→) to enter 'Yardage View'  
slide to right twice (→ →) to enter 'Put view'

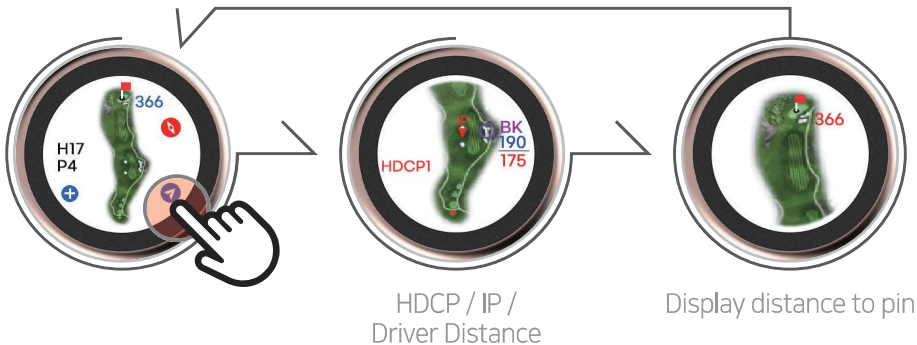

if touch screen during playback

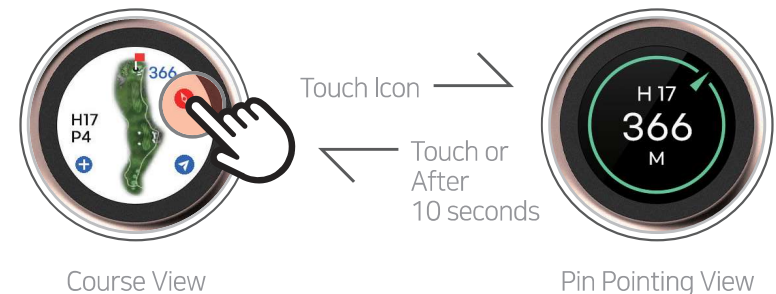


Display distance to bunker around landing zone

- 'Touch Pin Pointing'  icon to display a pop-up



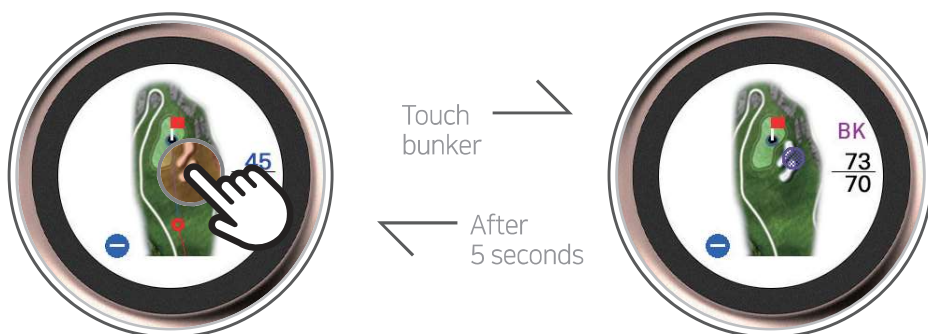


## B/H Zone (Bunker / Hazard)

## Real Green Undulation / Green Zoom

### Real Green Undulation

- Applied actual green undulation data with Shades

### Green Zoom

- Zoom in : Touch **+** icon
- Zoom out : Touch **-** icon



Real Green Undulation

Green Zoom

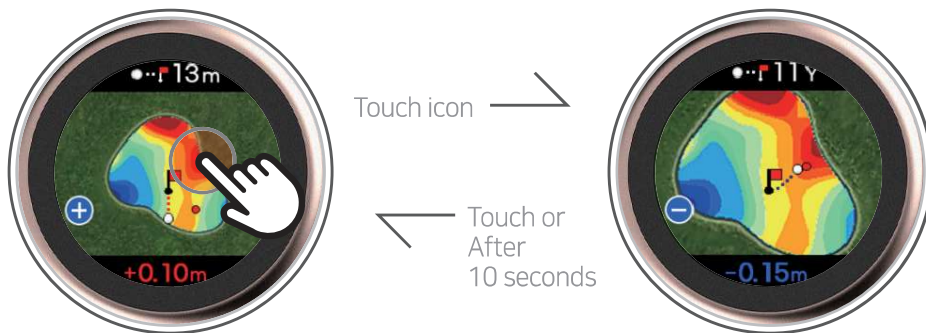
- In steep slopes such as 2nd-level green, arrows are displayed for easy identification
- Touch +/- Icon on 'Green view' is possible to Zoom in / out twice





## Put View

- Slide to left On 'Green View' Screen to enter 'Put View' shows distance and slope to a pin



- Display distance to the pin when touch where to know
- Touch +/- Icon to Zoom in/ out
- Drag on Zoom in Screen to move



## Active Green

- Automatically sets green's shape depending on player's position





## How to Connect to Application

### ► Activate Bluetooth



① Slide downward from watch screen



② Touch 'Connect' to activate Bluetooth



③ Check authentication number of T8

Search and install 'My Voice Caddie' on  Play Store /  Appstore.

## RESET



Press and Hold the Power button for 10 seconds will reset and restart.



The small hole on the top of the watch is **not reset button**.

Pressing with a pointed object can cause damage and is not designed to be pressed.

# Cautions for Use

- The time to locate the satellite in the golf mode may vary depending on reception environment (climate and topography).
- The battery may deplete faster in regions with poor satellite reception and cold weather. To maximize battery use, it is advised to switch on the device outdoors.
- Storing the device in a hot place such as inside your car in summer and a humid place such as golf bag may cause device failure.
- Taking a shower or entering the bathroom with wearing a watch can cause defective.
